



For us to properly document your injuries caused by your motor vehicle collision please send the following:

- 1. Police Report:** If one has been filed, the information on this form can help us understand the mechanism of your injuries.
- 2. Insurance Cards:** automobile insurance
- 3. Insurance Declaration Page:** This main page from your automobile insurance give us more information than you might imagine and will also help your attorney.
- 4. Your health insurance or Medicare card and coverage details:** This can be obtained from your health insurance company. You should be able to call or go online and have the information sent to us.
- 5. Hospital reports, x-rays, and other tests:** We will need to see copies of any treatment you have had since your motor vehicle collision.
- 6. Other doctor's reports:** If you have seen any other doctors since your crash, the information in their files can be very helpful in diagnosing and treating your injuries.
- 7. Prior doctor's reports (5 years):** The insurance company may try to say your injuries were pre-existing. Having prior records from *all your doctors for the past five years* will help up to prove otherwise; and if there are pre-existing conditions, this information will help us show how those conditions were worsened by the crash.
- 8. Copy of auto repair estimate:** The information on this can be helpful not only to the doctor but also to your attorney. If you have not had an estimate yet, let us know and we will find you a shop that works for you and not for the insurance company.
- 9. Pictures:** Any pictures you have from the auto body shop, scene of the crash, or bruises on your body can help us to document your injuries.

The more information you provide us the more we will have to work with in determining the proper diagnosis and treatment plan.
